Matt 16:24-27

24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, **If any man will come after me**, let him **deny himself**, and take up **his cross**, and **follow me**. **25** For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. **26** For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? **27** For the **Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father** with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.(KJV)

Matt 16:28 Verily I say unto you, **There be some standing here**, which shall not taste of death, till they see the **Son of man coming in his kingdom**.

Matt 17:1-2

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, **2** And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. *(see Matt.16:18-20, Acts 20:28, Eph.1:22-23, 3:21, 5:23-24, Col.1:18-20)

Matt 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him**.(KJV)

Matt 17:8 And when they had lifted up their eyes, **they saw no man, save Jesus only**.(KJV)

Matt 28:16 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain **where Jesus had appointed them**.(KJV)

Matt 28:18-20

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth**. **19** Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: **20** Teaching them to observe all things **whatsoever I have commanded you**: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

Col 1:12-14

12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: **13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and **hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son**: **14** In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:(KJV)

Matt 24:23-31

23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. **24** For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. **25** Behold, I have told you before. **26** Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not. **27** For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also **the coming of the Son of man be**. **28** For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together. **29** Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall

the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: **30** And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see **the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven** with power and great glory. **31** And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.(KJV)

Matt 24:35-39

35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away. **36** But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only. **37** But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. **38** For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, **39** And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; **so shall also the coming of the Son man be.**(KJV)

Matt 24:44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not **the Son of man cometh.** (KJV)

Matt 24:46-47

46 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when **he cometh shall find so doing.** **47** Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.(KJV)

Matt 24:48-51

48 But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, **My lord delayeth his coming;** **49** And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; **50** The lord of that servant **shall come in a day when he looketh not for him,** and in an hour that he is not aware of, **51** And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.(KJV)

Matt 25:31-34

31 When **the Son of man shall come in his glory,** and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: **32** And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: **33** And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. **34** Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:(KJV)

Matt 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:(KJV)

Matt 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. (KJV)

Matt 26:63-64

63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God. **64** Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see **the Son of man** sitting on the right hand of power, and **coming in the clouds of heaven.**(KJV)

Acts 1:8-11

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. **9** And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, **he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.** **10** And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; **11** Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, **shall so come in like manner** as ye have seen him go into heaven.(KJV)

1 Cor 15:22-24

22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. **23** But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's **at his coming.** **24** **Then cometh the end**, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. (see **Matt.28:18-20**)

Phil 3:20-21

20 For our **(1)conversation** is in heaven; **from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:** **21** Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.(KJV)

Definitions: (1)conversation- 4175 politeuma (pol-it'-yoo-mah); from 4176; a community, i.e. (abstractly) **citizenship** (figuratively): KJV-- conversation.

1Thes 2:19 For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ **at his coming?**(KJV)

1Thes 3:12-13

12 And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you: **13** To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, **at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.** (read **Matt.27:50-54**)

1Thes 4:14-18

14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which **sleep in Jesus** will God bring with him. **15** For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto **the coming of the Lord** shall not prevent them which are asleep. **16** **For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout**, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: **17** Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. **18** **Wherefore comfort one another with these words.**(KJV)

1Thes 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless **unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.**(KJV)

II Th 1:5-10

5 Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, **for which ye also suffer:** **6** Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; **7** **And to you who are troubled rest with us**, when the Lord Jesus **shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,** **8** In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus

Christ: **9** Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; **10** **When he shall come to be glorified in his saints**, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.(KJV)

II Th 2:1-3

1 Now we beseech you, brethren, **by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ**, and by our gathering together unto him,**2** That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. **3** Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;(KJV)

II Th 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the **brightness of his coming**:(KJV)

James 5:7-8

7 Be patient therefore, brethren, **unto the coming of the Lord**. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. **8** Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: **for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh**.(KJV)

2 Pet 1:16-21

16 For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and **coming of our Lord Jesus Christ**, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty. **17** For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. **18** And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount. **19** We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: **20** Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. **21** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.(KJV)

2 Pet 3:1-18

1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: **2** That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, **and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour**:**3** Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, **4** And saying, **Where is the promise of his coming?** for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. **5** For this they willingly are ignorant of, **that by the word of God** the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: **6** Whereby the world that then was, **being overflowed with water, perished**: **7** But the heavens and the earth, which are now, **by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire** against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. **8** But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, **that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day**. **9** The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.**10** **But the day of the Lord will come** as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.**11** Seeing then that all these things

shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, **12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God**, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? **13** Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. **14** Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. **15** And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our **beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; 16** As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are **(1)unlearned** and **(2)unstable (3)wrest**, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. **17** Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness. **18** But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.(KJV)

Definitions:

(1)unlearned- 261 amathes (am-ath-ace'); from 1 (as a negative particle) and 3129; **ignorant:** KJV-- **unlearned.**

(2)unstable- 793 asteriktos (as-tay'-rik-tos);**unfixed**, i.e. (figuratively) **vacillating:** KJV-- **unstable.unsteadfast**

(3)wrest- 4761 strebloo (streb-lo'-o);figuratively, **to pervert:** KJV-- wrest.1) **to twist, to turn awry**

THE LOCATION FOR THE SCRIPTURES MENTIONED DURING THE AUDIO:

John 17:14-21

14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. 15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. **16** They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **17** Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. **18** As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. **19** And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. **20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21 That they all may be one;** as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (KJV)

Mark 13:1-2

1 And as he went out of the temple, one of his disciples saith unto him, Master, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here! **2** And Jesus answering said unto him, Seest thou these great buildings? there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

2 Tim 2:11-16

11 It is a faithful saying: **For if we be dead with him**, we shall also live with him: **12 If we suffer**, we shall also reign with him: **if we deny him, he also will deny us: 13 If we believe not**, yet he abideth faithful: **he cannot deny himself. 14** Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers. **15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. **16** But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. (KJV)

2 Tim 3:12-17

12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. **13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.** 14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; 15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works. (KJV)

Acts 20:28-30

28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. 29 **For I know this**, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock. 30 **Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.** (KJV)

Matt 7:21-23

21 **Not every one that saith unto me**, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV)

Luke 6:46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? (KJV)

2 Cor 13:5-6

5 **Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith**; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be **(1) reprobates**? 6 But I trust that ye shall know that we are not reprobates. (KJV)

Definition: (1) reprobates-96 adokimos (ad-ok'-ee-mos);from 1 (as a negative particle) and 1384; unapproved, i.e. rejected; by implication, worthless (literally or morally): KJV-- castaway, rejected, reprobate, not standing the test, not approved; that which does not prove itself as it should: unfit for, unproved, spurious, reprobate

II Th 3:1-6

1 **Finally, brethren**, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you: 2 And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith. 3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. 4 And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you. 5 And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ. 6 **Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, (1) that ye withdraw yourselves** from every brother that **(2) walketh (3) disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.** (KJV)

Definitions:

(1) that ye withdraw yourselves-4724 stello (stel'-lo);probably strengthened from the base of 2476; properly, to set fast ("stall"), i.e. (figuratively) to repress (reflexively, abstain from associating with): KJV-- avoid, withdrawself, to remove oneself, to withdraw oneself, to depart to abstain from familiar intercourse with one.

(2) **walketh**-4043 peripateo (per-ee-pat-eh'-o); from 4012 and 3961; to tread all around, i.e. walk at large (especially as proof of ability); figuratively, to live, deport oneself, follow (as a companion or votary): KJV-- go, be occupied with, walk (about), Hebrew for, to live, to regulate one's life, to conduct oneself, to pass one's life.

(3) **disorderly**-814 ataktos (at-ak'-toce); adverb from 813, irregularly (morally): KJV— disorderly, deviating from the prescribed order or rule.

Mark 9:43-48

43 And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: **44 Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.** **45 And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off:** it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, **into the fire that never shall be quenched:** **46 Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.** **47 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out:** it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire: **48 Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.** (KJV)

1 Pet 2:9-11

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: **10** Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. **11 Dearly beloved,** I beseech you as **(1) strangers** and **(2) pilgrims,** abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; (KJV)

Definitions:

(1) strangers-3941 paroikos (par'-oy-kos); from 3844 and 3624; having a home near, i.e. (as noun) a by-dweller (alien resident): KJV-- foreigner, sojourn, stranger, in the New Testament, a stranger, a foreigner, one who lives in a place without the right of citizenship, metaphorically: without citizenship in God's kingdom, one who lives on earth as a stranger, a sojourner on the earth, used of Christians whose home is in heaven.

(2) pilgrims-3927 parepidemos (par-ep-id'-ay-mos); from 3844 and the base of 1927; an alien alongside, i.e. a resident foreigner: KJV-- pilgrim, stranger, sojourning in a strange place, a foreigner, in the New Testament, metaphorically, in reference to heaven as the native country, one who sojourns on earth.

1 Pet 1:13-17

13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; **14 As obedient children,** not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: **15** But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; **16** Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. **17 And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's (1) work,** pass the time of your **(2) sojourning** here in **(3) fear:** (KJV)

Definitions:

(1) work-2041 ergon (er'-gon); from a primary (but obsolete) ergo (to work); toil (as an effort or occupation); by implication, an act: KJV-- deed, doing, labour, work.

(2) sojourning-3940 paroikia (par-oy-kee'-ah); from 3941; foreign residence: KJV-- sojourning, X as strangers, a sojourning, dwelling in a strange land, metaphorically, the life of a man here on

earth is likened to a sojourning.

(3) in fear-5401 phobos (fob'-os);from a primary phobomai (to be put in fear); alarm or fright: KJV-- be afraid, + exceedingly, fear, terror, fear, dread, terror; what strikes terror

Phil 3:20 For our **(1) conversation** is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: (KJV)

Definition: (1) conversation is in heaven-4175 politeuma (pol-it'-yoo-mah); from 4176; a community, i.e. (abstractly) citizenship (figuratively): KJV—conversation, the administration of civil affairs or of a commonwealth, the constitution of a commonwealth, form of government and the laws by which it is administered, a state, a commonwealth; the commonwealth of citizens 4176 politeuomai (pol-it-yoo'-om-ah);middle voice of a derivative of 4177; to behave as a citizen (figuratively): KJV-- let conversation be, live, to avail oneself of or recognize the laws

1 Pet 4:17-19

17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? **18** And if **(1) the righteous (2) scarcely** be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? **19** Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator. (KJV)

Definitions:

(1) the righteous-1342 dikaios-righteous, observing divine laws, in a wide sense, upright, righteous, virtuous, keeping the commands of God

(2) scarcely be saved-3433 molis (mol'-is);probably by var. for 3425; with difficulty: KJV-- hardly, scarce (-ly), + with much work, with difficulty, hardly, not easily, that is, scarcely, very rarely.

Matt 27:50-54

50 Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. **51** And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; **52** And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, **53** And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. **54** Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God. (KJV)

Luke 4:1-8

1 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, **2 Being forty days tempted of the devil.** And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered. **3** And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. **4** And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God. **5 And the devil,** taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. **6 And the devil said unto him,** All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. **7 If thou therefore wilt worship me,** all shall be thine. **8 And Jesus answered and said unto him,** Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. (KJV)

Eph 2:5-10

5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) **6** And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: **7** That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. **8 For by grace are ye saved through faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: **9** Not of works, lest any man should boast. **10 For we are his workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus **unto good works**, which God hath before ordained **that we should walk in them**. (KJV)

Acts 20:32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, **and to give you an inheritance among all them which are (1) sanctified**. (KJV)

Definition: (1) sanctified-37 hagiazo (hag-ee-ad'-zo); from 40; to make holy, i.e. (ceremonially) purify or consecrate; (mentally) to venerate: KJV-- hallow, be holy, sanctify, to render or acknowledge, or to be venerable or to hallow, to separate from profane things and to dedicate to God, to consecrate things to God, to purify internally by a renewing of the soul.
