

## LIE NOT ONE TO ANOTHER

### Col 3:9-11

9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;  
10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him: (KJV)

**Col 3:9 (1)Lie not** one to another, seeing that ye have **(2)put off** the old man with his deeds

**Definitions: (1) Lie** not-5574 pseudomai (psyoo'-dom-ahee); middle voice of an apparently primary verb; to utter an untruth or attempt to deceive by falsehood: KJV-- falsely, lie.1) to lie, to speak deliberate falsehoods 2) to deceive one by a lie, to lie to. **(2) put off** the old man -554 apekduomai-1) wholly put off from oneself denoting separation from what is put off

### Col 3:9 ... Lie not one to another, (KJV)

### Ps 101:6-8

6 Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me.  
7 He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth **(1)lies** shall not **(2)tarry** in my sight.  
8 I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD. (KJV)

**Definitions: (1) telleth lies** 8267 sheqer (sheh'-ker); from 8266; an untruth; by implication, a sham (often adverbial): KJV-- deceit (-ful), false (-hood, -ly), feignedly, liar, + lie, lying, vain (thing), wrongfully.a lie, a deception, a falsehood b) deceit, fraud, wrong; fraudulently, wrongfully (as adverb) c) falsehood (injurious in testimony); testify falsehood, false oath, swear falsely **(2)tarry** in my sight-3559 kuwn (koon); a primitive root; properly, to be erect (i.e. stand perpendicular); hence (causatively) to set up, fasten, firm, be fitted, be fixed, set (aright, fast, forth), be stable, (e-) stablish, stand, tarry,

### Isa 63:8

8 For he said, Surely they are my people, children that will not lie: so he was their Saviour.

### Jer 9:3

3 And they bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD.(KJV)

### Jer 9:5

5 And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity.(KJV)

### Jer 23:21-32

21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied.  
22 But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then

they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

23 Am I a God at hand, saith the LORD, and not a God afar off?

24 Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

25 I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed.

26 How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart;

27 Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

28 The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

29 Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

30 Therefore, behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that steal my words every one from his neighbour.

31 Behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that use their tongues, and say, He saith.

32 Behold, I am against them that prophesy false dreams, saith the LORD, and do tell them, and cause my people to err by their lies, and by their lightness; yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the LORD.(KJV)

#### **John 8:44**

44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.(KJV)

#### **Eph 4:20-25**

20 But ye have not so learned Christ;

21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.(KJV)

#### **1 Tim 1:9-11**

9 Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, **for liars**, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;

11 According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust.

**Titus 1:12-14**

12 One of themselves, even a prophet of their own, said, The **Cretians are always liars**, evil beasts, slow bellies.

13 This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

14 Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.

**Rev 21:8**

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, **and all liars**, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.(KJV)

**Rev 21:27**

27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or **maketh a lie**: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.(KJV)

**Rev 22:15**

15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and **maketh a lie**.(KJV)

**Col 3:9 ... ye have put off the old man with his deeds; (KJV)****Rom 6:4-9**

4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

7 For he that is dead is freed from sin.

8 Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:

9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.(KJV)

**Eph 4:20-24**

20 But ye have not so learned Christ;

21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.(KJV)

**Col 3:1-8**

1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.  
3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.  
4 When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.  
5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:  
6 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:  
7 In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.  
8 But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.(KJV)

### **Col 3:9 ... additional scriptures (KJV)**

#### **Ps 15:1-2**

1 LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? who shall dwell in thy holy hill?  
2 He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and **speaketh the truth (1)in his heart**.(KJV)

**Definition: (1)in his heart**-3824 lebab-the inner man, the mind, the will, the heart, the soul, understanding inner part, the midst 4) the mind, knowledge, the thinking, reflection, the memory 5) inclination, resolution, determination (of will) 6) the conscience 8) as the seat of the appetites 9) as the seat of the emotions and the passions 10) as the seat of the courage

#### **Ps 34:13**

13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking **(1)guile**.(KJV)

**Definition: (1)guile**-4820 mirmah (meer-maw'); from 7411 in the sense of deceiving; fraud: KJV-- craft, deceit (-ful, -fully), false, feigned, guile, subtilly, treachery.

#### **Ps 101:7**

7 He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: **he that telleth lies shall not (1)tarry in my sight**.(KJV)

**Definition: (1)**3559 kuwn-to be firm, to be stable, to be established 1) to be set up, to be fixed to be secure, **to be enduring**

#### **Matt 5:37**

37 But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil.(KJV)

#### **Rom 13:12**

12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.(KJV)

#### **1 Cor 15:45-49**

45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that

which is spiritual.

47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.

48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.

49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.(KJV)

#### **Eph 4:29**

29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.(KJV)

#### **Col 2:10-12**

10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.(KJV)

#### **1 Tim 1:3-4**

3 As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine,

4 **Neither give heed to fables** and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.(KJV)

#### **James 3:4-10**

4 Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!

6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

7 For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind:

8 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

9 Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.

10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.(KJV)

#### **1 Pet 3:4**

4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.(KJV)
