

Neither be ye idolaters

1Cor.10:7

1 Cor 10:1-7

- 1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea;
- 2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;
- 3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat;
- 4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.
- 5 But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
- 6 Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.
- 7 Neither be ye idolaters, as were some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.(KJV)

1 Cor 10:7 Neither be ye **(1)idolaters**, as were some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up **(2)to play**.(KJV)

Definitions: (1)idolaters-1496 idololatries (i-do-lol-at'-race);from 1497 and the base of 3000; an image- servant or) worshipper (literally or figuratively): KJV-- idolater.1) a worshiper of false gods, a idolater used of any one even Christian, participating in any way in the worship of the heathen, especially one who attends their sacrificial feasts and eats of the remains of offered victims 2) **a covetous man as a worshiper of Mammon.** **Worshiper** 2. (n.) Deep and often immoderate affection or devotion: • idolization • idolatry• adoration • veneration • passion • obsession, serve 4. (v.) To like or enjoy enthusiastically, often excessively: • cherish • dig (slang) • dote • lap up (colloquial) • revere • glorify• relish• revel in • dote upon • love • be infatuated with • loathe (antonym) • despise (antonym) • abhor (antonym) • hate (antonym). **(2)to play**-3815 paizo (paheed'-zo); from 3816; to sport (as a boy): KJV-- play.1) to play like a child 2) to play, to jest 3) to give way to hilarity, especially by joking, singing, or dancing

1 Cor 10:7 ... be ye idolaters, (KJV)

Deut 9:12-21

- 12** And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted themselves; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.
- 13** Furthermore the LORD spake unto me, saying, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiffnecked people:
- 14** Let me alone, that I may destroy them, and blot out their name from under heaven: and I will make of thee a nation mightier and greater than they.
- 15** So I turned and came down from the mount, and the mount burned with fire: and the two tables of the covenant were in my two hands.
- 16** And I looked, and, behold, ye had sinned against the LORD your God, and had made you a molten calf: ye had turned aside quickly out of the way which the LORD had commanded you.
- 17** And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and brake them before your eyes.

18 And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

19 For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.

20 And the LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I prayed for Aaron also the same time.

21 And I took your sin, the calf which ye had made, and burnt it with fire, and stamped it, and ground it very small, even until it was as small as dust: and I cast the dust thereof into the brook that descended out of the mount.(KJV)

Ps 106:19-26

19 They made a calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image.

20 Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of an ox that eateth grass.

21 They forgat God their saviour, which had done great things in Egypt;

22 Wondrous works in the land of Ham, and terrible things by the Red sea.

23 Therefore he said that he would destroy them, had not Moses his chosen stood before him in the breach, to turn away his wrath, lest he should destroy them.

24 Yea, they despised the pleasant land, they believed not his word:

25 But murmured in their tents, and hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD.

26 Therefore he lifted up his hand against them, to overthrow them in the wilderness: (KJV)

Matt 6:21-24

21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (KJV)

1 Cor 5:9-13

9 I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:

10 Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world.

11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or **an idolater**, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

12 For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? do not ye judge them that are within?

13 But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.(KJV)

1 Cor 6:9-11

9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, **nor idolaters**, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.(KJV)

1 Cor 10:13-22

13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

14 Wherefore, my dearly beloved, **flee from idolatry**.

15 I speak as to wise men; judge ye what I say.

16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?

17 For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.

18 Behold Israel after the flesh: are not they which eat of the sacrifices partakers of the altar?

19 What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing?

20 But I say, that the things which the **(1)Gentiles** sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have **(2)fellowship** with devils.

21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

22 Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he?(KJV)

Definitions: **(1)Gentiles**-1484 ethnos (eth'-nos);probably from 1486; a race (as of the same habit), i.e. a tribe; specially, a foreign (non-Jewish) one (usually by implication, pagan): KJV-- Gentile, heathen, nation, people, the unconverted to the truth, unbelieving. **(2)fellowship**-2844 koinonos-a partner, associate, comrade, companion, sharer, in anything, used of the altar in Jerusalem on which the sacrifices are offered, sharing in the worship of the Jews, partakers of (or with) demons, brought into fellowship with them, because they are the authors of heathen worship.

1 Jn 5:17-21

17 All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.

18 We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.

19 And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.

20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

21 Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.(KJV)

1 Cor 10:7 ... The people sat down to eat and drink, (KJV)

Exod 32:6-8

6 And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play.

7 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves:

8 They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. (KJV)

Exod 32:17-19

17 And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, There is a noise of war in the camp.

18 And he said, It is not the voice of them that shout for mastery, neither is it the voice of them that cry for being overcome: but the noise of them that sing do I hear.

19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount. (KJV)

1 Cor 10:7 ... additional scriptures (KJV)

Gen 35:2 Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments: (KJV)

John 12:25-26

25 (1)He that loveth his life (2)shall lose it; and (3)he that hateth his life in this (4)world shall keep it unto life eternal. 26 If any man (5)serve me, (6)let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. (KJV)

Definitions

(1)He that loveth his life-5368 phileo (fil-eh'-o);from 5384; to be a friend to (fond of [an individual or an object]), i.e. have affection for (denoting personal attachment, as a matter of sentiment or feeling; to kiss (as a mark of tenderness): KJV-- kiss, love, to approve of, to like, to sanction, to be fond of doing; to be accustomed to, used to doing (something).

(2)shall lose it-622 apollumi-to destroy, to put out of the way entirely, to abolish, to put an end to ruin, to render useless, to kill: metaphorically, to devote or give over to the eternal misery in hell, to perish, to be lost, to be ruined, to be destroyed.

(3)he that hateth his life-3404 miseo (mis-eh'-o);from a primary misos (hatred); to detest (especially to persecute); by extension, to love less: KJV-- hate (-ful), to be hated, to be detested.

(4)in this world-2889 kosmos (kos'-mos); probably from the base of 2865; orderly arrangement, i.e. decoration; by implication, the world (in a wide or narrow sense, including its inhabitants, literally or figuratively [morally]): KJV-- adorning, world, the ungodly multitude; the whole mass of men alienated from God, and therefore hostile to the cause of Christ, world affairs, the aggregate of things earthly, the whole circle of earthly goods, endowments riches, advantages, pleasures, etc., which although hollow

and frail and fleeting, stir desire, seduce from God and are obstacles to the cause of Christ.

(5)If any man **serve** me-1247 diakoneo-to be a servant, an attendant, a domestic, to serve, wait upon, to minister to one, ministered unto, to attend to anything, that may serve another's interests, to minister a thing to one, to serve one.

(6)let him follow me-190 akoloutheo (ak-ol-oo-theh'-o);from 1 (as a particle of union) and keleuthos (a road); properly, to be in the same way with, i.e. to accompany (specially, as a disciple): KJV-- follow, reach, to follow one who precedes, join him as his attendant, accompany him, to join one as a disciple, become or be his disciple: to side with his party.
