

## THEY THAT FEARED THE LORD SPAKE OFTEN ONE TO ANOTHER

### **Mal 3:13-18**

**13** Your words have been stout against me, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, What have we spoken so much against thee? **14** Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts? **15** And now we call the proud happy; yea, they that work wickedness are set up; yea, they that tempt God are even delivered. **16** Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. **17** And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. **18** Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not. (KJV)

**Reference Scriptures for walking mournfully:** (See John 12:25-26; Phil.1:29-30; 2Tim.2:11-16 and 1Pet.4:1-2)

**Mal 3:16** Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. (KJV)

### **Mal 3:16 ... that feared the LORD: Ref. Scriptures (KJV)**

#### **Gen 22:1-13**

**1** And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am. **2** And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. **3** And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him. **4** Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off. **5** And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you. **6** And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid it upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together. **7** And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering? **8** And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. **9** And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood. **10** And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. **11** And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. **12** And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me. **13** And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son. (KJV)

**Job 28:28** And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding. (KJV)

**Ps 33:18-19**

**18** Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy; **19** To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. (KJV)

**Ps 111:7-10**

**7** The works of his hands are verity and judgment; all his commandments are sure. **8** They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness. **9** He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and reverend is his name. **10** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever. (KJV)

**Ps 112:1** Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. (KJV)

**Ps 147:6-11**

**6** The LORD lifteth up the meek: he casteth the wicked down to the ground. **7** Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God: **8** Who covereth the heaven with clouds, who prepareth rain for the earth, who maketh grass to grow upon the mountains. **9** He giveth to the beast his food, and to the young ravens which cry. **10** He delighteth not in the strength of the horse: he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man. **11** The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy. (KJV)

**Acts 9:29-31**

**29** And he spake boldly in the name of the Lord Jesus, and disputed against the Grecians: but they went about to slay him. **30** Which when the brethren knew, they brought him down to Caesarea, and sent him forth to Tarsus. **31** Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied. (KJV)

**Acts 10:1-2**

**1** There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian band, **2** A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway. (KJV) (See also verse 33; to hear all things that are commanded thee of God)

**Mal 3:16 ... spake often one to another: Ref. Scriptures (KJV)**

**Deut 6:6-8 (See also Eph.6:4 bring them up)**

**6** And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: **7** And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. **8** And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

**Eph 5:19-21**

**19** Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; **20** Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; **21** Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

**1Thes 5:9-11**

**9** For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, **10** Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him. **11** Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do. (KJV)

**1Thes 5:14** Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. (KJV)

**Heb 3:12-14**

**12** Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. **13** But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. **14** For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end; (KJV)

**Heb 10:22-25**

**22** Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. **23** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) **24** And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: **25** Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. (KJV)

**Heb 12:14-15**

**14** Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: **15** Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled; (KJV)

**Mal 3:16 ... and the LORD hearkened: Ref. Scriptures (KJV)**

**Ps 139:4** For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.

**Isa 59:1-2**

**1** Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: **2** But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (KJV)

**Jer 8:4-6**

**4** Moreover thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD; Shall they fall, and not arise? shall he turn away, and not return? **5** Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return. **6** I hearkened and heard, but they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle. (KJV)

**Ezek 8:17-18**

**17** Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose. **18** Therefore will I also deal in fury: mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: and

though they cry in mine ears with a loud voice, yet will I not hear them. (KJV)

**Micah 3:1-5**

**1** And I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and ye princes of the house of Israel; Is it not for you to know judgment? **2** Who hate the good, and love the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones; **3** Who also eat the flesh of my people, and flay their skin from off them; and they break their bones, and chop them in pieces, as for the pot, and as flesh within the caldron. **4** Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings. **5** Thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that make my people err, that bite with their teeth, and cry, Peace; and he that putteth not into their mouths, they even prepare war against him. (KJV)

**Matt 18:19-20**

**19** Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. **20** For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them. (KJV)

**Acts 10:4** And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, Lord? And he said unto him, Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God. (KJV)

**John 9:31** Now we know that God heareth not **(1)sinners**: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth. (KJV)

**Definition:(1)sinners-268** hamartolos (ham-ar-to-los');from 264; sinful, i.e. a sinner: KJV--devoted to sin, a sinner: preeminently sinful, especially wicked.

**Mal 3:16 ... a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD: Ref. Scriptures (KJV)**

**Phil 4:3** And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life. (KJV)

**Rev 3:5-6**

**5** He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. **6** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (KJV)

**Rev 21:25-27**

**25** And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. **26** And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. **27** And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life. (KJV)

**Mal 3:16 ... that thought upon his name Ref. Scriptures: (KJV)**

**Ps 20:7** Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God. (KJV)

**Ps 94:19** In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul. (KJV)

**Ps 104:33-34**

**33** I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. **34** My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the LORD. (KJV)

**Isa 26:3** Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. (KJV)

**Heb 4:12-13**

**12** For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. **13** Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do. (KJV)

FOR THOSE THAT FEAR NOT THE LORD AND SPEAK NOT OFTEN ONE TO ANOTHER: **Ref. Scriptures:**

**Ps 10:1-5**

**1** Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? why hidest thou thyself in times of trouble? **2** The wicked in his pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken **(1)in the devices** that **(2)they have imagined**. **3** For the wicked boasteth of his heart's desire, and blesseth the covetous, whom **the LORD abhorreth**. **4** The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts. **5** His ways are always **(3)grievous**; thy judgments are far above out of his sight: as for all his enemies, he puffeth at them. **6** He hath said in his heart, I shall not be moved: for I shall never be in adversity. **7** His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and vanity. (KJV)

**Definitions**

**(1)in the devices**-4209 mezimmah-a plan, purpose, discretion, a device, a plot, a purpose, discretion, intent, witty invention, lewdness, mischievous devices, thought (evil).

**(2)they have imagined**-2803 chashab-to think, to plan, to esteem, to calculate, to invent, to make a judgment, to imagine, to count, to charge, to impute, to value, to regard, to be accounted, to be thought, to be esteemed, to be considered.

**(3)grievous**-2342 chuwl (khood);or chiyl (kheel); a primitive root; properly, to twist or whirl (in a circular or spiral manner), i.e. (specifically) to dance; figuratively, to pervert etc.

**Ps 50:17-23**

**17** Seeing thou **(1)hatest instruction**, and castest my words behind thee. **18** When thou sawest a **(2)thief**, **(3)then thou consentedst** with him, and hast been **(4)partaker** with **(5)adulterers**. **19** Thou givest thy mouth to evil, and thy tongue frameth deceit. **20** Thou sittest and speakest against thy brother; thou slanderest thine own mother's son. **21** These things hast thou done, and I kept silence; thou thoughtest that I was altogether such an one as thyself: but I will reprove thee, and set them in order before thine eyes. **22** **Now consider this**, ye that forget God, **lest I tear you in pieces**, and there be none to deliver. **23** Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God.(KJV)

**Definitions:**

**(1)Seeing thou hatest**-8130 sane'; a primitive root; to hate, to be hateful, hater (personally):

KJV-- enemy, foe, to be hated, odious, X utterly....**(2)**When thou sawest a **thief**-1590 gannab; from 1589; a stealer: KJV-- thief. 1589 ganab; to thief (literally or figuratively); by implication, to deceive: KJV-- carry away, X indeed, secretly bring, steal (away), get by stealth....**(3)**then thou consentedst with him-7521 ratsah; a primitive root; to be pleased with: KJV-- (be) accept (-able), accomplish, set affection, approve, consent with, delight (self), enjoy, (be, have a) favour (-able), like, observe, **pardon**, (be, have, take) please (-ure)....**(4)**and hast been **partaker**-2506 cheleq; from 2505; properly, smoothness (of the tongue); also an allotment: KJV--a portion, a share, a part, territory (chosen) portion, seductiveness, flattery, inheritance....**(5)**with **adulterers**: **James 4:4** Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? **whosoever** therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (See also **1Peter 4:1-2; 1John 2:15-17 and 4:5-6**)

**Matt 6:24** No man can serve two masters: for either **he will hate** the one, and **love** the other; or else **he will hold to** the one, and **despise** the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (KJV)

### Definitions

**No man**-3762 oudeis; including feminine oudemia; and neuter ouden; from 3761 and 1520; not even one (man, woman or thing), i.e. none, nobody, nothing: KJV—nought, no one....Can **serve**-1398 douleuo-to be a slave, serve, to do service, be in bondage; metaphorically, to obey, to submit to, **in a good sense**, to yield obedience, **in a bad sense**, of those who become slaves to some **base power**, to yield to, to give oneself up to....Two **masters**-2962 kurios; supreme in authority, i.e. (as noun) controller: KJV-- God, Lord, master, Sir, he to whom a person or thing belongs, about which he has power of deciding, the possessor and disposer of a thing, the owner; one who has control of the person, the master, is a title of honor expressive of respect and reverence, with which servants salute their master....For either **he will hate** the one-3404 miseo ;from a primary misos (hatred); to detest; by extension, to love less:KJV--to hate, to pursue with hatred, to be hated, to be detested....And **love** the other 25 agapao; to love (in a social or moral sense): KJV-- used of persons: to welcome, to entertain, to be fond of, to love dearly, used of things: to be well pleased, to be contented at or with a thing....Or else **he will hold to** the one-472 antechomai; adhere to; by extension to care for: KJV-- hold fast, support, hold to him firmly, cleave to, paying heed to him....And **despise** the other-2706 kataphroneo; from 2596 and 5426; to think against, i.e. disesteem: KJV— to think little or nothing of.

**There are two Masters; the first is God Almighty the Holy One. The other is the devil the worldly one, but yet mighty:(Jude1:9; Rev.13:6-9)**

### Master #1 is the Master of all. Ref. Scriptures:

**1 Cor 6:19** What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? **20** For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. (KJV)

**1 Cor 7:22** For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant. **23** Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men. **24** Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with God.

**Master #2 is by God's intent (1John5:19; lieth) the master of this world, the things that are in it and the glories of them! Ref. Scriptures:**

**Luke 4:5** And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms

of the world in a moment of time. **6** And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.**7** If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine. **8** And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. **(Listen to Jesus: John17:14 and 20)**

**2 Cor 4:3** But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them **that are lost: 4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds** of them **which believe not**, lest the **light** of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should **shine** unto them.

**Rev 12:9** And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

**Rev 13:7-9**

**7** And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. **8** And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. **9** If any man have an ear, let him hear. (KJV)

THERE ARE ALSO BOOKS OF REMEMBRANCE WRITTEN FOR THOSE THAT THINK UPON THE NAME OF **MASTER#2, THE DEVIL, AND SPEAK OF HIM OFTEN. Ref. Scriptures:**

**Matt 12:35-37**

**35** A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. **36** But I say unto you, **That every idle word that men shall speak**, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. **37** **For by thy words** thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. (KJV)

**Rev 20:12-15**

**12** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and **the books were opened:** and **another book was opened, which is the book of life:** and the dead were judged out of those things which **were written in the books, according to their works.** **13** And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. **14** And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. **15** And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
